The Victoria Public Library has been busy the past year – and there are lots of new things to be excited about in the coming year!

Imagine learning new recipes in a hands-on cultural cuisine class. Picture teens learning about drones and using critical thinking skills to problem-solve their way out of a jungle-themed escape room. Imagine children and their parents listening to a story and singing the alphabet at Storytime. These are just a few examples of the 460 programs offered at the Victoria Public Library last year, all made possible by your support. More than 21,000 people attended a program at the library in the past fiscal year.

This winter, we also teamed up for a new "Winter Passport" program. Kids created winter passports with the help of the Friends at the annual Gingerbread Workshop. Participants receive a stamp for each program attended. Once the passport is full, participants turn them in for a chance to win a prize. The winner will be announced April 2nd. This program was a fun way for our teams to collaborate, as well as spread the word about awesome contributions the Friends of the Library make to library programs.

The library held a ribbon-cutting ceremony for the Anytime Pickup Locker in March and officially launched the service. Imagine the convenience of picking up your latest library reserve day or night. That's the beauty of the Anytime Pickup Locker. This new service allows patrons to reserve materials and pick them up 24/7 by selecting the locker when requesting a reserve.
