



Message from the President:



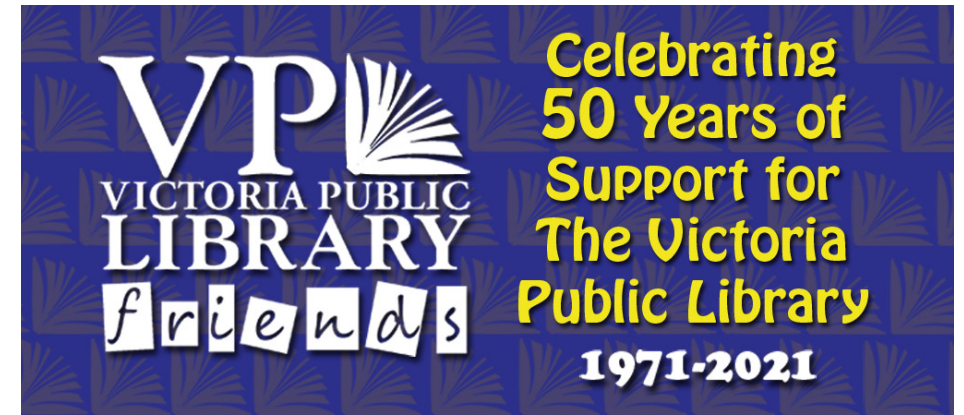
The past 18 months have shown us that our FRIENDS are THE BEST!

These certificates are valid for any \$5 merchandise purchase at any of the three 2022 Friends of the Library Book Sales.

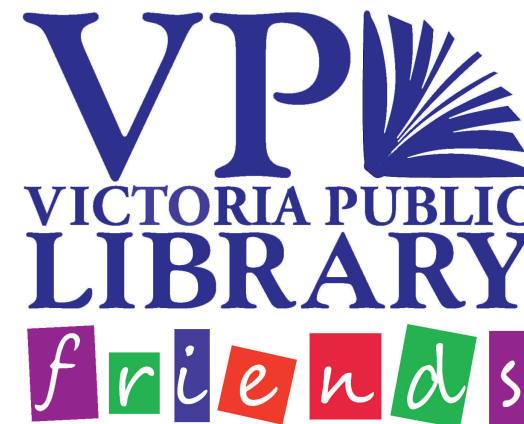
