With the Friends funding, the Library is able to offer programs such as the Summer Reading Program, Gingerbread Adventures, and dozens of other programs at no cost to participants.

We look forward with excitement to the future of our Library and our partnership with it. The City of Victoria worked with a library design consultant this year in developing a strategic plan and a framework for ideas of how to enhance the facilities and services of the Victoria Public Library. That plan has been turned over to the City leadership and in coming years, we will start to see elements of that plan come to fruition. As these dreams become reality, our entire community will be the beneficiaries.

We know everyone reading this note has been impacted by inflation and economic uncertainty.

The Friends and the Victoria Public Library have also had to adjust to rising costs. That is what led the Friends Board of make the difficult decision to raise prices for future book sales. It has been over two decades since our last price increase so you can tell we are not prone to making these price decisions lightly.

Starting with the January sale, our hardback fiction and non-fiction books will be \$2 and soft cover/paperback books will be \$1. Audiobooks on CDs, DVDs and music CDs will remain \$1. We will still wrap up the close of sales on Saturdays with the Book Bag Special. Bring your official Friends of the Library Book Bag and fill it with as much remaining merchandise as you can for only \$1 with unlimited refills. Book Bags are available for purchase at the Library Circulation Desk and at the sale for only \$7. They are reusable from sale-to-sale.

I hope you will renew your membership soon and we look forward to seeing you at the next Friends Book Sale January 15-21, 2023!

VPL SUMMER READING PROGRAM GROWS Friends Proudly Supports the Program

Members of the FRIENDS turned out to volunteer at the kickoff party that opened the Summer Reading Program at the Library on June 4. Hundreds of children, parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles and friends turned out for the Saturday kickoff...and that was just the beginning!

Over the course of the summer, the Library reports there were 64 programs associated with Summer Reading. That is in addition to 86 Story Times.

According to a summary from the Library, 7359 people participated in Summer Reading Programs plus 830 in attendance at Story Times during the two months of the program.

The Summer Program has experienced huge growth over the past four years. In 2019, before COVID, the Library counted 76 Summer Reading participants. In 2022, a total of 175 participants were enrolled in the program and 444,952 pages of reading were recorded!

The FRIENDS of VPL provides most of the funding in support of the activities in the Summer Reading Program. This keeps the programs available at no cost to the children, teens, and adults who enjoy reading, creating, learning, and fellowship opportunities.

Coming soon: The Gingerbread Holiday Event which is 100% funded by the FRIENDS. And, the event will be back at the Community Center for in-person fun for the first time in two years. Follow the Library's Facebook page for updates!
